MFP Mail Server setting requirements when using Gmail

1. Open the web page for your printer.
2. Select the **Administrator login** button & enter the device username & password.
3. Select **Admin Setup**, expand **Network**, & then select **Mail Server**.
4. Enter the information as specified by Google for the Gmail server.


